

## GROUP CAMP INFORMATION

The Group Camp at Sequoyah State Park has 10 A-frame cabins, accommodating up to 115 people. Each cabin has heat and air conditioning. There is a bathroom with men's and women's facilities and heated showers. The cabins are furnished with bunk beds and mattresses – guests furnish their own bedding. The camp includes a large community building with heated and air conditioned dining hall and cook's sleeping quarters. The dining hall can seat up to 150 people. The kitchen is furnished with cookware, dishes and utensils, walk-in cooler and upright freezer. A cooking grill and picnic shelter are available for group cookouts. Applications for reservations are accepted up to one year in advance. To make a reservation please call the Park Office.

Sequoyah State Park has tennis courts, volleyball courts, playgrounds, fishing areas and 12 miles worth of hiking trails. The park's swim beach is located along the lake in the Choctaw tent campground. Three Forks Nature Center is located just before the Choctaw camp area and provides program activities. Fee activities within the park include horseback riding, hayrides, golf and boat rentals. There is a \$10.00 fee for day use/parking per vehicle.

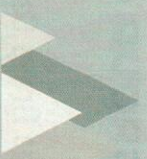

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The camp shall be under the supervision of park management. Park management shall have the authority to restrict the use of buildings or areas, when, in their opinion, such use will be detrimental to the grounds, buildings or operation of the facility. Park management may also restrict use of buildings or areas when a small group is using the camp.

2. The director of State Parks reserves the right to close a camp and cancel group permits when use of the facilities would be detrimental to the health and safety of the campers.

3. Each group must appoint a camp director (25 years of age or older) who will be responsible for:

- a) Keeping the buildings, groups and beaches in a clean, neat, orderly condition.
- b) Advising park management immediately of any injuries incurred by any member of the group.
- c) Any damage to state owned property.
- d) Making prior arrangements for the services of a doctor in the nearest community for emergency cases.

4. Each group intending to use water-related recreational facilities must provide a waterfront director who holds a Red Cross WSI, or YMCA Leader/Examiner Certificate (18 years of age or older), who will be responsible for the safety of all members of the group.

5. In children's camps, a minimum of one counselor (at least 18 years old) must be provided for every eight campers.

6. Recreational Vehicles may be parked in group camp at the two designated RV hookup areas.

7. Check-in is between 2:00pm-4:00pm (may be able to check-in earlier with prior approval). Check-Out is before noon.

# A-FRAME CABINS

Cabin 1 sleeps 4 people and has a shower and bathroom.

Cabins 2-5 & Cabin 8 sleeps 10.

Cabin 6 sleeps 13.

Cabin 7 sleeps 12.

Cabins 9 and 10 sleeps 16.

There is a bathroom in the area with heated showers.

The cook's quarters in the Community

Building sleeps 4 and has a shower and a bathroom.

# RATES

## GROUP CAMP

Group Camp rates start at \$350.00 per night on weekdays and \$375.00 per night on weekends (Friday & Saturday) for up to 48 people. For more than 48 people, there is a \$5.00 per person per night fee for each additional person, seven years of age and older.

A cleaning deposit of \$200.00 is charged in addition to the first night fee. Upon check out, the cleaning deposit is applied to the balance due, provided the areas used are clean and in order.

There is a \$25.00 per night per cabin fee for each additional cabin opened.

Parking Pass is only included while in Group Camp area.

## COMMUNITY BUILDING

When the Group Camp is not rented, the Community Building may be rented separately for day use. It runs \$200.00 per day with a \$200.00 refundable cleaning deposit. Parking Pass is only included while in Group Camp area.
